Alfons and Yvonne will share their journey with us – from the unimaginable heartbreak of kids who lose the battle against HIV to the tremendous joy and fulfilment of seeing formerly shattered children thriving in this community.

This couple came to Rehoboth in 2003 when there were just 2 kids, Lebo and Londiwe, living on the property. With help from Boomerang and other donors, they have since supervised the building of an entire village: 11 houses, a clinic, a creche, guest and volunteer accommodation, sports field, agricultural crops and a vegetable garden. They have established an ongoing earnings source by building various businesses, and the overall success of the village has underpinned substantial sponsorship and governmental support.

The village is now essentially complete. There are 44 kids and 11 foster-parents, living in a loving, stable environment closely replicating that of a nuclear family. As well as relief carers and support staff, indirectly 100 Rehoboth family members in the community are also beneficiaries of the village. Having achieved the miracle that is the village at Murchison, Alfons and Yvonne are now intent on using this blueprint to build further villages in South Africa.
