As the Chairperson of Kilusang Mayo Uno (KMU), Mr Elmer Bong Labog is a leader in the struggle for trade union rights in the Philippines, one of the most dangerous countries in the world to be a unionist. Since the rise to power of President Duterte, more than forty-three unionists have been murdered.

Under Duterte, workers' wages are pegged far below living standards, contractualisation remains rampart, and unemployment is still one of the worst in Asia. If Duterte can't do anything about it, then he must go.
