## (100) Days

### Gaza lacks the basic necessities of life!

- **(100) days and Gaza lacks all necessities of life (water, food, medicine, infant formula, housing, clothing, and means of communication)**
- The continuity of fallen victims of civilian casualties highlights the importance of implementing an immediate ceasefire and providing a safe entry of humanitarian aid.
- The martyrs in Palestine have reached (22,404), of which (22,141) of them since 7 October 2023.
- (527) martyrs in the West Bank last year (2023), (318) of them were martyred after October 7, 2023.
- One Bathroom to (800) person inside emergency shelters designated for UNRWA in Gaza.
- The Israeli occupation considers journalists and medical personnel its main targets in Gaza.
- (195,000) Palestinian workers have stopped supporting their families due to the cessation of work in the Israeli labor market since the events of October 7, 2023
- **due to the aggression on Gaza since the 7th of October 2023:**
  - (11,000) martyred children in Gaza & (92) martyred children from West Bank
  - (26,000) injured children.
  - (3,800) children under the rubble.
  - (18,000) children lost one or both of their parents.
  - (450,000) children lost their homes.
  - (1,000) children had their limbs amputated.
  - (340,000) children suffer from malnutrition.

#### **(PGFTU) emphasize on the statement of the Arab Trade Union Confederation in its 14th session of the General Council meeting (12/11/2023):**

- Our Commitment to the principles and foundations of the International Trade Union Confederation (ITUC) by strengthening international labor solidarity and the right of people to freedom and self-determination.
- End the attacks and massacres against the residents of Gaza and immediate implementation of the ceasefire and bringing in humanitarian aid, in implementation of the Fourth Geneva Convention (1949) for the protection of civilians during wars.
- Emphasizing the illegality of the settlements in occupied Palestinian territories, in accordance with international resolutions (446, 452, 456, 478), emphasizing the cessation and boycott of investments in the settlements, and calling on United Nations organizations to immediately implement these resolutions.
- Urging the shipping and docking workers to boycott the loading of all equipment, weapons, and materials destined for the occupation authorities.

- The ATUC calls for an organization of a simultaneous solidarity supporting Palestine.

The missing under rubble: (12,000), at least (6,000) of them are children and women.

- Since October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the number of Palestinian detainees reached (7,480) From the West Bank and Gaza combined, from West Bank (5,850) and at least (4,000) from Gaza.
- The total number of Palestinian detainees reached (11,000) including nearly (150) women and (800) children.
- (99) of medical services were arrested and (10) journalists and media workers.

#### The Health Facilities: (380) aggression against the health sector

- Non-functioning health facilities due to fuel shortages or bombing resulted in closing of (30) hospitals out of (35) hospitals in Gaza Strip, and (53) primary health clinics out of (72) health care centers are out of service.
- (104) ambulances destroyed

**Holy places:** heavy bombing resulted in (7) damaged churches, and (240) mosques were damaged as a result of the bombing, of which (142) were completely demolished.

#### The Education Facilities:

The total percentage of damaged schools and universities is (40%), (295) were partly damaged, and (95) were damaged completely.

(42) UNRWA facilities were exposed to damage, including several used as shelters for displaced residents, one of them was targeted directly resulting in (13) Martyrs and (195) Injuries.

- **(200) archaeological and heritage sites destroyed by the occupation**
- **(65,000) tons of explosives were dropped by the occupation on Gaza.**
- **Complete isolation of Gaza by cutting Electricity, Water, communication & Internet all over the Strip of Gaza.**
- **(1,000,000) Gaza city residents are suffering from the threat of starvation as a result of the siege and bombing the bakeries.**

#### **Employees:**

Since the beginning of the war, there has been no income for the workers because they stopped working in the Israeli labor market. Some of them began selling their home furniture to feed their family, so that their monthly losses are estimated at more than (1) billion and (250) million shekels, which paralyzed the economy in the West Bank, and caused... By dismissing more than (80) thousand workers in the Palestinian labor market.

- Total of Palestinian workers in Israel (190,000).
- The Martyrs from workers in 2023 (113).

#### **In the Israeli labor market in 2023:**

- (79) workers.
- (2) killed by settlers.
- (2) by war clashes.
- (12) Gazan workers killed inside Israel.
- (3) killed by torture under detention

#### **In the labor market in Gaza and West Bank in 2023:**

- (27) Martyr workers in West Bank.
- (1) killed by settlers while picking olives in his own land on October 28 / 2023.
- (1) A taxi driver was targeted by the occupation forces in Hebron Governorate on November 13/2023
- (1) was targeted by the occupation forces at the Beit Aynoun Junction in Hebron while working as a parcel distributor on December 20/2023
- (5) Martyrs were killed on their way to their workplaces.

#### **Detainees:**

PGFTU emphasizes that the number of Gazan workers inside Israeli labor market approached (19,000) workers, since October 7th, 2023, all their work permissions were cancelled.

We estimated a number of (10,000) workers who worked in in Israel until the 7<sup>th</sup> of October, after the 7<sup>th</sup> of October events, PGFTU in the West Bank hosted (5,838) workers and provided them with (housing, food, clothing), (80) were arrested out of (982) workers while going back from the West bank to Gaza.

meanwhile the Israeli, arrested (4,000) workers from their workplaces inside Israel or on checkpoints on their way trying to go back home, (3,200) at least released and deported to Gaza.

- **Three workers from Gaza were arrested in the town of Aqraba, southeast of the city of Nablus, at dawn on Saturday, 2/12/2023.**
- **(67) workers from Gaza were arrested in the town of Feroun, south of the city of Tulkarm, at dawn on Thursday, 7/12/2023.**
- **(15) workers from Gaza were arrested in the Bidya municipality complex, with the occupation army storming the council of PGFTU in the town of Bidya, located northwest of Salfit Governorate, today, Sunday morning, 1/14/202, and tampering its contents.**

### **The hosting places of Gazan Workers in West Bank:**

Workers' distribution in (West Bank): Jerusalem (63), in Jericho (1481), in TulKarm (163), in Ramallah (1194), Hebron district- in center (112), in Doura (85), in Yatta (50), in Halhoul (150) Qalqilya (1042), In Bethlehem (146), in Jenin (390), in Salfit (70), in Toubas (303), in Nablus (589), **(982) of them returned to Gaza.**

According to a Palestinian worker from West Bank, in his interview with Al-Jazeera TV, he said that he has been under detention with hundreds of Gazan workers in an Israeli military camp (Anatout) in West Bank, An Israeli officer informed them that they are under detention because of the Israelis kidnapped in Gaza, and they will not be released as long as the kidnapped are still In Gaza.

According to the released Gazan workers who were recently released through the (Karam Abo Salem) crossing, east of Rafah in the Gaza Strip, they stressed that they were tortured and abused during their investigation by the Israeli occupation army, and this was proven by numbers of videos published by the occupation army, stripping the workers naked and torturing them.

### **PGFTU demands and emphasize on:**

1. There is No security and military solution for Gaza.
2. It is not possible to accept or deal with the isolation of Gaza from the Palestinian State.
3. Immediate ceasefire and stop the attacks on Gaza.
4. International protection, Stop the bombing and siege on Hospitals.
5. Providing humanitarian and medical Aid for Gaza Strip, and immediate protection for medical staff.
6. Stop chasing the workers in their workplaces both inside of Israel and in the West Bank.
7. Permissions for workers to go back home safely to the West Bank and Gaza.
8. Immediate release of all the prisoners from Gaza and West Bank.
9. Pressure on the Israeli government to compensate Palestinian workers who work in the Israeli labor market due to their cessation of work following the war for approximately (3) months.
